8588. Sawtooth "Atelier" for Young Children (Pre-K ages 3-5)

Half-Day only: 9 am - 12 pm each day
(Atelier, pronounced at-l-yey, is a French word meaning a workshop or studio, especially of an artist, artisan, or designer.) Drawing influence from the preschools of Reggio Emilia, teachers and children will explore various visual languages - drawing, painting and clay to achieve mastery of tools and materials. Children will utilize their expressive languages to help make meaning of their ideas and concepts. The teachers will observe and document the children's ideas to guide them in collaborative and individual projects that emerge from the children's interests. Each child will collaborate with the teacher in documenting a portfolio of their expressive experience.

8528. Digital Photography Studio - This class will teach the basics of framing, composition, color, and lighting while exploring the world around us through the lens of a camera. We will then return to the computer lab to upload and modify our photographs. After printing our photos, we will explore the art of photo-montage and photojournalism. Cameras and materials provided. No experience needed.

8527. Mural Mania- Do you like to think, draw, and paint BIG? Together we will explore the collaborative art of murals, from traditional painting and design techniques to contemporary graffiti-art. We will also work on a special surprise location to transform a public space through our visual ideas.

8516. Under the Sea - What mysterious creatures there are under the water... and we plan on using our imaginations to visit them! We will learn how to make a print from a sea creature, create coral reefs from clay, give a new meaning to "painted Fish" and generally have a great time with art galore!

8525. Earth Energy - Discover the power of nature... explore the elements and how they relate to the arts. From color and value studies (rainbows and quality of light through the atmosphere) to wind-powered whimsies, mobiles and wind socks. Our serious play with shadow and light, drawing projects and pin-hole cameras will heighten your awareness of the world. Alexander Calder and Georges Seurat will help us see how artists use the wonders of nature.

8526. Let's Go Dumpster Diving! Like to imagine unique creations made from things you find around the house? We will design plans for crazy creatures and imaginative models of new play spaces inspired by architecture and the world around us, and build our inventions using recycled materials, found objects, wire, glue, and add all sorts of embellishments.

8522. Animal Kingdom - There will be lots of drawing and painting this week (inspired by many live models.) Other projects include a painted wooden sculpture and clay animals. Let us know if you have any sort of animal that would make a great model!

8518. Magical Mystery Book Tour Adventures untold await us as we use stories and fairy tales as inspiration to create great art! We will start our day reading a story and then using clay, fairy dust, fancy fibers, and a ton of imagination, we will create our own make believe world of adventure and mystery! We may even make some books of our own!

8517. Travel-Rama - Spend the day exploring faraway lands with exciting adventures! Paintbrush and imagination in hand, we will pack our bags with paintings, camp clothes, fishing poles, and much more for this week of exotic happenings. Bring a map or create one as we "create" our way across the continents!

8520. Dribble, Splat, Splash!

Dribble paint like Pollack, splash color like Monet, and splat shapes like Picasso. We will be exploring the techniques of some of the world's greatest artists this week. Join us on this wonderful art history journey. Be prepared to discover your own artistic style.

8523. Puppet Theatre- We will have all week to get ready for the puppet show given on Friday at 3:00! Design and make the stage, the scenery, the script, and the puppets. Join us for this very exciting week.

8524. Claymation Studio- We will collaborate on a stop-motion animated film using colorful, non-hardening plasticine clay as our medium. Students will learn all the basics - from script writing to storyboarding, creating characters, and working as a team on their short film as directors, producers, animators, and narrators. A DVD documenting students' films will be provided at the end of the week.

8521. At the Circus - Under the Big Top- Summer at Sawtooth would not be complete without this week of painted ponies, beaded bangles, clowns on stilts and so much more. We will paint our faces, create wire sculptures, and make clay come alive in this week of fun. Join us for our summer grand finale!
